

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
Hallym University, Republic of Korea
and
Dalat University, Vietnam
for
Cooperation on the K-University Project

Hallym University, Republic of Korea, hereinafter referred to as HU, and Dalat University, Vietnam, hereinafter referred to as DLU, in recognition of their shared commitment to advancing education through technology, wish to formalize their cooperation in the K-University Project. The K-University Project is an initiative undertaken by HU as part of its Glocal University 30 designation by the Education Ministry of the Republic of Korea, aimed at enhancing global and local educational capacities through innovative digital platforms and AI-driven learning solutions. This Memorandum of Understanding outlines the framework for collaboration to support educational and research initiatives that leverage AI and digital platforms to benefit students and faculty from both institutions.

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to establish a collaborative relationship for the K-University Project, which aims to innovate digital education infrastructure and content delivery. This cooperation is intended to promote knowledge exchange, academic collaboration, and joint initiatives that advance the field of AI-driven education.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

HU and DLU agree to promote and develop academic cooperation in the following areas:

1. **Joint Research and Development:** Collaborating on research initiatives and technological advancements within the K-University Project, focusing on AI applications in education, curriculum development, and digital tools.
2. **Development and Deployment of AI Educational Solutions:** Jointly developing and deploying AI-powered educational solutions, including AI tutors, AI advisors, AI teaching assistants, and AI professors, to enhance learning and teaching outcomes for both institutions.
3. **Exchange Programs:** Facilitating the exchange of faculty, researchers, and students to foster skills and knowledge relevant to the K-University Project. Exchange participants will receive educational credit from their home institution for their work or studies at the host institution.

4. Workshops and Training: Organizing joint workshops, training sessions, and seminars to enhance both institutions' capacity in AI, online education platforms, and digital transformation in education.
5. Resource Sharing: Sharing academic materials, research publications, and digital resources related to the K-University Project.
6. Innovation in Educational Models: Jointly exploring and implementing innovative teaching and learning models, including the development of AI-based learning companions, virtual classrooms, and micro-campus solutions.

ARTICLE III: AGREEMENT OF IMPLEMENTATION

An Agreement of Implementation will detail the specific scope of each activity, including:

1. Responsibilities of HU and DLU for each agreed activity.
2. Schedules and timelines for carrying out joint initiatives.
3. Any additional items deemed necessary for the effective implementation of each collaborative activity.

ARTICLE IV: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND PUBLICATION

1. HU and DLU will share data and research findings generated from the K-University Project. Intellectual property rights for any discoveries, inventions, or digital products will be managed under terms specified in each Agreement of Implementation.
2. Written consent from both parties will be required for the publication or public use of joint research results or findings.

ARTICLE V: SETTLEMENT OF DIFFERENCES

Any differing views or interpretations arising from this Memorandum of Understanding shall be resolved through mutual consultation and negotiation.

ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENTS, DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended only by written agreement between HU and DLU.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective on the date of signing and remain in effect for five (5) years, with automatic annual renewal, unless formally terminated or replaced by a new Memorandum of Understanding.
3. Each party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by providing written notice at least six (6) months in advance. If terminated, any ongoing activities will continue as specified under their respective Agreements of Implementation.

This Memorandum of Understanding is authentic. As witness to their consent to this Memorandum of Understanding, the appropriate authorities hereunto provide their signatures.
